



How to Reserve a Picnic Shelter at a City Park

To reserve a picnic shelter for a company or private party at one of our Tustin parks, please follow the instructions below.

1. Visit the site to determine if the park location will meet your needs.
2. Find out availability by contacting Tustin Parks and Recreation at (714) 573-3326. Have an alternate facility to choose from in the event the picnic shelter you chose is already reserved. Remember, residents and non-residents have different fees.
3. The application must be filled out in person at City Hall, Parks and Recreation Services Department 300 Centennial Way, Tustin . Be prepared to show proof of residency with a current picture ID and utility statement (water bills not accepted), or rental agreement with current address.
