Dear Resident:

As a follow-up to my letter sent to you on 10/29/2024, an application was submitted in accordance with the updated permit parking program requesting a new permit parking area along Farmington Road and Andrews Street. The signatures on the petition have now been validated and new signs designating the limits of this new addition to Permit Parking District 13 are being ordered and will be installed soon on Farmington Road and Andrews Street. Enforcement on these streets will not begin until the signs are in place.

As a reminder, your residence is located within this expanded Permit Parking District 13 (see attached map). This means that all residents within the expanded permitted area with valid permits obtained from the Tustin Police Department, and only those residents, may park on the designated public street frontage within this permitted area from 2 am to 6 am daily.
