



## 2020 Tustin Tiller Days Frequently Asked Questions

- \* Admission is Free \* Carnival Ride Wristbands or Tickets Can Be Purchased at the Event \*
- \* Games Take Tickets Only \* Vendors Take Cash Only \* Several ATMs Are Located On-Site \*

### Q. When is it?

- Friday, October 2: 4:00 to 11:00 pm
- Saturday, October 3: 12:00 to 11:00 pm
- Sunday, October 4: 12:00 to 8:00 pm (Carnival stays open until 10:00 pm)

### Q. Where can I park?

- Free parking along streets where it is allowed
- Parking at the event is \$10 (Columbus Tustin Middle School fundraiser)

### Q. When and where is the Pancake Breakfast?

- Saturday, October 3
- 7:30 to 9:30 am
- Location: Tustin Area Senior Center, 200 South C Street, Tustin 92780
- \$6 per person: Pancakes, eggs, sausage, orange juice, and hot coffee

### Q. When and where is the Parade?

- Saturday, October 3
- 10:00 am
- Start: Corner of Main Street and Pacific Street
- Finish: Prospect Avenue and Beneta Way at Festival grounds

**Q. Where can I buy a 2020 Tiller Days T-Shirt?**

- 2020 shirts are available at the Information Booth for just \$10!
- Vintage shirts are also available

**Q. Will there be a beer booth?**

- \$2.00 per wristband (wristbands are required and only available to attendees 21 and older)
- \$7.00 per cup of beer or wine
- Beer and wine tickets are for the day of purchase only (different colors each day)
- Service begins when the event opens
- Service ends 1 hour before the event is over
- Alcohol not allowed in the Carnival area
- Alcohol only permitted in the Food Court and Festival area
- Credit cards accepted for payment

**Q. When is the Backyard Brew Festival Hand-Crafted Beer Tasting?**

- Sunday, October 4 from 2:00 to 6:00 pm near the Main Stage
- No alcohol in Carnival area
- More information to be announced this summer!

**Q. What about the Tiny Tiller Contest?**

- Contest Date: October 3 at 2:00 pm (contestants must be at the stage NO LATER than 1:30 pm)
- Age: 3 to 6 years old
- Location: Community Stage
- How to register: Contestants can pre-register at the Parks and Recreation Department at City Hall or register on the day of the event at the Community Stage
- \$10 entry fee
- Children judged on personality, humor, and smiles (not required to perform)
- Not a competitive pageant (just for fun)
- 10 winners in each age group receive prizes
- All contestants invited to Prince and Princess Party at 3:00 pm

**Q. I'm a vendor. What do I need to know?**

- Check-in: 8:00 am to 12:00 pm Friday, October 2 – all vehicles must clear the field by 1:00 pm
- Vendors must be ready for business by 4:00 pm
- Parking is located at Columbus Tustin Middle School and one vendor pass is included in the booth fee
- Additional passes may be purchased at check-in for \$10
- Booths have electricity but the vendor must bring 59ft extension cord, own lighting, and power cord
- Chairs and tables available for rent for all three days: \$10/table, \$3/chair or \$5 for two chairs (or you may bring your own)
- Awards will be handed out for Best Decorated and Most Spirited booths and judging will be Saturday after 3:00 pm
- Ice for vendors can be purchased for \$5 per 20 lb. bag from the Information Booth
- Security: All vendors should decide what equipment and inventory to leave overnight

- The City of Tustin is not responsible for theft, damage, vandalism, or breakage
- Overnight security will be on-site Friday and Saturday nights
- Clean up: Vehicles will be allowed on the field at 9:00 pm on Sunday
- For-profit vendors must have a City of Tustin Business License, available for the event at the Business License counter in City Hall

**Wristbands:**

- Wristbands include unlimited Carnival rides (does not include Fairway games)
- One-day Presale Wristbands may be purchased for \$25 at the Parks and Recreation Office, 300 Centennial Way, until Friday, October 2 at 4:00pm
- At the event, wristbands may be purchased for \$30 at the ticket booths
- Individual ride tickets and sheets of tickets will be sold at the event
