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PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tustin Police Department, under the direction of Police Chief Stu Greenberg, is an accredited agency through the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA). The CALEA accreditation program requires agencies to comply with applicable standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services. Standard applicability is based on agency size, function, and other factors.

To receive reaccreditation, the Tustin Police Department is scheduled for a site-based assessment to verify the agency is meeting the applicable professional standards. This review will be conducted July 6-8, 2021.

As part of this assessment, members of the public are invited to provide input during a virtual Public Information Session hosted by CALEA on Tuesday, July 6, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. Details for joining the meeting are available on the Tustin Police Department's [website](#).
