



2021 Tustin Street Fair and Chili Cook-Off

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When is the event?

A: Sunday, August 15, 2021, 11am to 6pm.

Q: Where will it take place?

A: Peppertree Park, 230 W. First Street, Tustin 92780 and C Street (from First to Main Street in Old Town Tustin)

Q: Will there be admission?

A: Yes, admission is \$5 per person, children 13 and under are FREE. Pre-paid admission includes three chili tasting tickets. Gate admission is \$5 per person and is limited.

Q: How do I purchase tickets?

A: Via Eventbrite at www.tustintickets.com

Q: Can I purchase tickets at the event?

A: Pre-registration is recommended; however, admission tickets at the gate will be available based on event occupancy. Cost will be \$5 and will not include three chili tasting tickets.

Q: Are there other costs?

A: Yes.

- Non-profit food vendors have varying prices for their food/beverage items. Most accept cash only.
- Chili tickets are \$1 per tasting.
- Alcohol is \$7 for beer/wine/champagne; \$8 for premium beer. An alcohol wristband is required for all adult beverages at \$2.
- Craft and commercial vendors also have varying costs for their products. Method of payment varies and may include cash and/or credit card.

Q: Will streets be closed?

A: Yes. C Street from First to Main Street, Second Street and Third Street (both from C Street to El Camino Real), and B Street from Second to First Street.

Q: How do I access the event?

A: The event will be gated and will include three entry points.

- Second Street, off El Camino Real
- Third Street, off El Camino Real
- C Street, off Main Street

Q: What bands are playing?

A: On the Peppertree Park Stage:

- 11am - 4 Alarm Band (Top 40 Pop-Dance Hits)
- 1:30pm - Redneck Rodeo (Country)
- 4pm - The Reflexx (80s)

Q. Will there be a dance floor?

A. Yes, Peppertree Park has a dancing area in front of the stage.

Q: How early can I show up to the event?

A: The event will kick-off at 11am. We recommend you make time to find parking and get to the admission gate on time. Gates will open no earlier than 10:30am.

Q: Can I bring my own lawn chair and/or blanket to the event?

A: Only if you plan on sitting down to listen to the live music. The park has limited benches and we will set-up some chairs; however, we recommend you bring a lawn chair or blanket and enjoy the lawn area.

Q: Can I set-up an umbrella and/or canopy?

A: No. Limited umbrellas will be placed throughout the park to allow for some shade for those choosing to sit and listen to the live music.

Q: Will the playground be open?

A: Yes. Parents are asked to supervise their children.

Q: What are the current COVID-19 related guidelines that pertain to Concerts in the Park?

A: Effective June 15, California Department of Public Health (CDPH) guidelines allow for up to 10,000 people to gather for outdoor live events without any restrictions pertaining to vaccine verification/negative testing, capacity limitations, physical distancing or masking. These guidelines apply to Tustin's Street Fair and Chili Cook-off because the attendance of the event falls significantly below that number. Q: Where can I park?

A: Public parking is available behind Rutabegorz Restaurant at Stevens Square (between "C" and Main Street), at the Water Facility parking lot on 275 Main St. (corner of Main and Prospect), and on side streets (park at your own risk). Parking is also available at the Columbus Tustin Recreation Center (17522 Beneta Way, Tustin 92780); there will be a shuttle to the event and back. Parking will not be allowed in the Tustin Area Senior Center lot.
