Q: When is the Art Walk and Craft Crawl?

A: The Art Walk and Craft Crawl will be on Saturday, October 15 from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Q: Where will the Art Walk and Craft Crawl take place?

A: The Art Walk and Craft Crawl will be in Old Town Tustin.

Artists will be displaying their work on the sidewalk along Main St. from Prospect Ave. to C St. More artists and activities will be on the streets of El Camino Real from 6th St. to 3rd St.

Q: Will there be admission cost?

A: Admission is FREE.

Q: Are streets going to be closed during this event?

A: Yes, El Camino Real will be closed from 6th St. to Main St. and Main St. to 3rd St. Main St. will be open for cars to drive through.

Q: Do vendors accept credit card payment?

A: Each artist will have their own form of payment, we recommend you also bring cash.

Q: Will you be selling alcohol?

A: We will be selling beer and wine at the event.

Q: Can I walk around with beer and wine?

A: Yes, you can walk around El Camino Real in the designated drinking areas.

Q: Will there be food vendors?

A: No, we will not have vendors selling food that day; however, restaurants in the area will be open and we encourage you enjoy their delicious food.

Q: Are there any attractions for children?

A: Yes, there will be a Kids Village hosted by the Tustin Library.

Q: Where can I park?

A: Public parking is available as follows:

- Behind Rutabegorz Restaurant at Stevens Square (between “C” and Main Street)
- At the Water Facility parking lot on 275 Main Street (corner of Main and Prospect)
- On side streets (park at your own risk)
- Civic Center, 300 Centennial Way, Tustin 92780
- Tustin Area Senior Center, 200 South C St.
