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

SYNOPSIS: Preciado went into the Canary Wireless store and asked the clerk to see a cell phone from behind the counter. The clerk held the cell phone box up for Preciado to see it and he grabbed it out of his hand and took the phone. Preciado left the store holding his waistband as if he had a weapon under his shirt. Preciado was arrested a few blocks from the store and the stolen cell phone was recovered.

NARRATIVE: On Monday, June 3, 2013 at 1252 hours I received a radio call of a robbery just occurred at Canary Wireless, 14001 Newport Avenue-B. Upon arrival I spoke to the store clerk, [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] told me on Monday, June 3, 2013 at approximately 1245 hours he was in the store talking to [REDACTED] when a male Hispanic dressed in gang style clothing walked in the store. [REDACTED] recognized the male as a person that had stolen another phone from him in May. (CR 13-2665) The male asked [REDACTED] if they had any iPhones for sale. [REDACTED] believed the male was going to steal them so he told him that they were currently out of the iPhone. The male then asked [REDACTED] if he could see the Galaxy smart phone that was hanging from a display rack behind the counter. [REDACTED] told the male that all the display phones were in front of him to try out. The male asked [REDACTED] if he could at least read the box. [REDACTED] took the phone in the box off the shelf and held it out so the male could read the box. The male reached out and grabbed the box out of [REDACTED]'s hands and said, "Now you can say I yanked it from you!" The male started to walk out of the store placing his hand under his shirt as if he had a weapon. The male said to [REDACTED] as he walked out the door, "Fucking bitch" and spit on the floor.

[REDACTED] told me he did not want to confront the male because he was afraid he might have a gun. [REDACTED] called the police and gave dispatch a detailed suspect description.

I spoke to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told me she works at the adjoining business and is friends with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was inside of the Canary Wireless store when the suspect walked in. [REDACTED] told be basically the same story as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was afraid of the suspect because of his violent behavior and his hand under his shirt.

Officer Newton located a subject matching the suspect description at Walnut and Newport. Officer Newton attempted to detain the suspect and the suspect began to actively resist him. Officer Newton was able to detain the subject. The suspect was identified as Rogelio Preciado. Preciado had thrown a new cell phone still in its packaging in the bushes when he saw Officer Newton. See Officer Newton's supplemental report for full details.

I took [REDACTED] to Officer Newton's location to see if he was the suspect that robbed him. I read [REDACTED] the in-field identification admonishment before we went to the location. As soon as [REDACTED] saw Preciado he told me, "Yeah that's him. I'm pretty sure he is also the same guy who took the cell phone last month. That guy had a large tattoo on his back." I took [REDACTED] back to his store.

I took [REDACTED] to Officer Newton's location to see if he was the suspect. I read [REDACTED] the in-field identification admonishment before we went to the location. [REDACTED] looked at Preciado and told me, "That's him!" I took [REDACTED] back to her business.

I spoke to the manager of the Canary Wireless store, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told me the serial number from the phone [REDACTED] stole. I compared it to the cell phone Officer Newton had found and it was the same phone. Officer Newton took a photograph of the cell phone and returned it to [REDACTED].

I advised Officer Howard that Preciado was positively identified as the suspect by both witnesses. Officer Howard placed Preciado under arrest. Preciado was taken to Western Medical Center for treatment for his injuries.

I spoke to Preciado at the hospital. Preciado began to ask me why he was arrested and told me he did nothing wrong. I told Preciado that I would like to talk to him about what happened but before I did I needed to advise him of his Miranda rights. Preciado told me he knew his rights and didn't want to talk to me. I did not ask Preciado any questions regarding this incident. Preciado was still being treated for his injuries at the time this report was completed.

I took photographs of Preciado's injuries. Preciado had a large skeleton wings tattoo across his entire back. I saw the tattoo when I photographed his injuries. I believe this tattoo may help identify Preciado as the suspect from the prior petty theft case. I have been speaking to Detective Gomez regarding this case and he requests this report be forwarded to him for addition investigation.

I request prosecution of Preciado for 211 P.C. Robbery and 148(a) (1) P.C. Resisting a police officer.

SYNOPSIS: A robbery suspect attempted to discard evidence and then refused to comply with commands.

NARRATIVE: I am assigned to the Tustin Police Department's south area patrol division. On June 3, 2013 at approximately 1252 hours, I was working in full uniform and operating marked police vehicle 802. I was stopped at the intersection of McFadden Ave and Newport Ave facing east in the #2 lane of eastbound Walnut Ave. TPD Dispatchers sent Officer Turner and Officer Breskin to the Boost Mobile store located at 14001 Newport Ave #B reference a robbery which had occurred 5 minutes prior to the time of call.

The victim ([REDACTED] [REDACTED]) described the suspect to TPD Dispatchers as a Hispanic male in his late 20's, missing a front tooth, a bruise around his right eye, a tattoo on his forearm, wearing a white shirt, black shorts and a black baseball cap.

While I was stopped at the solid red light, I observed a subject in my driver side mirror crossing McFadden Ave from north to south. The subject was wearing a black hat, white shirt and dark shorts. I turned my head to the right rear to observe the subject walking at a high rate of speed towards Walnut Ave east of McFadden Ave.

I made a u-turn at the intersection and drove east on Walnut Ave. I made a southbound turn onto Newport Ave and immediately saw the subject walking quickly on the west sidewalk. The subject looked straight at me but did not slow his pace. He entered the east driveway to Tustin Country Squire's apartment complex and continued to walk south.

This specific area is divided by approximately 50 yards of head high bushes, with random exits on the east side between the bushes, that lead onto the west sidewalk of Newport Ave just south of Walnut Ave. On the west side are garages belonging to the residents of Tustin Country Squires.

The subject (Later identified as **Rogelio Preciado**) looked at me again as I told him to stop through my open driver side window. I could not see if he was carrying anything in his left hand because his left hand was down by his left side, pushed closely to his body. As I came to a stop and exited my vehicle, Preciado looked at me once again, and then walked through an opening in the bushes. I said loudly, "Tustin PD Stop!" and he looked at me and said, "Why I didn't do anything". I could not see Preciado from the neck down because the bushes were too tall. I was unable to see Preciado's hands and out of fear he may have a weapon I drew my weapon and pointed it at him, ordering him to stop walking and come back around the bushes where I could see him. I requested additional follow officers to respond to my location using lights and sirens.

Preciado responded to my request with an array of profanities, saying he didn't do anything wrong and I had no reason to stop him because he was not on parole or probation. He walked towards me, around the tall bushes to where I was standing. I told him I would explain it to him after he sat down and he continued to yell at me. I told Preciado I was going to taser him if he did not comply with my commands.

Preciado sat on the ground facing me as he continued to yell profanities and tell me I had no reason to stop him. He was moving his hands and legs sporadically and I told him to no reach into his pockets. Preciado told me he could reach into his pockets if he wanted to and began to put both his hands in his pockets. I had not yet conducted a pat down or search of his pockets and was unsure if he was in possession of a weapon.

As Preciado reached into his pockets I approached him from the front and grabbed his left arm at his forearm. I told him to take his hand out of his pocket and place it behind his back and he said, "Fuck you I am not putting my hand behind my back". His left hand came out of his pocket and he

violently pulled his left arm away from my grasp and began an attempt to get off the ground.

Fearing that Preciado wanted to fight with me and he may be in possession of a weapon, I put all of my weight (170 Pounds) on him and attempted to gain control of his hands. I attempted several times to gain control of his hands but was unsuccessful because he was flailing them around. I struck Preciado on the forehead and right side of his face with my right fist approximately 3 times. I told him several times to stop fighting and to give me his hands but he did not comply. At one point, Preciado moved his body so abruptly; the force knocked my sunglasses off my face and to the ground where they broke into pieces.

I was able to put Preciado into a headlock using my left arm, which prevented him from getting to his feet. I gained control of his right hand but was unable to see his left. I could feel Preciado pushing against me in an attempt to get up so I hit him in the face three additional times with my right fist.

Officer Thornton arrived on scene and gained control of Preciado's left hand. Officer Thornton took my backup handcuffs out of the case, which are located on the back left of my duty belt. He placed the handcuffs on Preciado as Officer Howard, Officer Breskin, Officer Turner, Officer Nunley, Sgt. Lamoureux and Sgt. Greene arrived on scene. Preciado sustained facial injuries during the altercation and I requested Orange County Fire Authority respond to the scene to evaluate Preciado.

I believed Preciado had thrown something into the tall bushes when he walked through the opening to the sidewalk. I retraced the steps Preciado took and located a white Samsung Galaxy SII 4G in its original plastic cover. Officer Turner confirmed that the phone was the same phone stolen

from the Boost Mobile store. I took photographs of the stolen/recovered property.

Officer Turner transported the witness/victims to the scene where he conducted an in field line up. Both witnesses/victims said that Preciado was the suspect that committed the robbery at the store and stole the phone. Officer Turner confirmed the serial number of the recovered phone matched the serial number of the phone that was stolen.

I photographed the phone and returned it to Boost mobile where [REDACTED] signed the property release form (Attached). Refer to Officer Turner's original report for further.

Narrative:

I am a Detective assigned to the Tustin Police Department Gang Unit. My responsibilities include gang suppression, investigation, the gathering of intelligence and reviewing graffiti related offenses.

On 060413 at approximately 0726 hours, I responded to Western Medical Center Santa Ana (1001 N. Tustin Ave., Santa Ana CA 92705) to guard Rogelio Lopez Preciado who had been arrested by Officer Turner on 060313 for robbery. Preciado was seeking medical care due to complain of pain to his right eye.

I have had previous contacts with Preciado and he agreed to talk to me about the incident.

I read Preciado his Miranda Rights from my department issued Miranda card. Preciado answered "yes" to the questions advising he understood his rights. I asked if he wanted to tell me his side of the story and he said he did. The following is a summarization of his statements.

Preciado said he was in Tustin to drop off his sons backpack at the daycare located in the area of Newport Ave. and Andrews St. Preciado dropped off the backpack and began walking south on Newport Ave. towards the 5 freeway. Preciado saw a cell phone store in the area of Newport Ave. and El Camino Real. Preciado described the store as being located "Across from the Jack in the Box."

Preciado said he walked in to the cell phone store to look at the cell phones. Preciado said he had \$30 to place towards a new cell phone contract if he found something he liked. Preciado said the salesman within the store was being rude to him as he asked to see a cell phone. Preciado

said he asked the salesman if he could look at a cell phone and the salesman said, "No." Preciado said, the salesman ultimately allowed Preciado to see the cell phone and "Placed it" in Preciado's hand. Preciado said he was angry due to the salesman rudeness and walked out of the store without paying for the cell phone.

Preciado said he walked south on Newport Ave. to McFadden Ave. From McFadden Ave. he walked west to Walnut Ave. Preciado crossed the street on to eastbound Walnut Ave. Preciado reached Newport Ave. Preciado began walking southbound on Newport Ave. from Walnut Ave. when he was contacted by a TPD Officer.

Preciado said the TPD Officer ordered him to the ground. Preciado said he panicked and threw the cell phone in a bush near him. Preciado said he told the Officer, "I don't want to speak to you, I want to speak to your watch commander." Preciado said the Officer told him he was under arrest and for Preciado to turn around. Preciado said he threw his hands up to his side and said, "What!" Preciado said the Officer then punched him several times and placed him on the ground. Preciado said the Officer told him to stop resisting as additional Officers arrived to assist.

Preciado said he has been fighting a methamphetamine addiction since the age of 13 years old. Preciado said he use to steal cell phones from stores to fund his drug habit. Preciado said he had taken one "Norco" pill and had a 24 ounce beer approximately an hour prior to the incident on 060313.

Preciado said he had sustained a cut to the right side of his right eye prior to the incident with the TPD Officer on 060313. Preciado said the prior incident was due to a subject punching him in the face (NFD).

Preciado refused to talk to me about anything else related to other crimes or criminal activity prior to 060313.



SYNOPSIS: This report is follow-up to a robbery report.

NARRATIVE: I am assigned to the Tustin Police Department's south area patrol division. On June 5, 2013 at approximately 1015 hours I contacted [REDACTED] reference a robbery that occurred at his place of employment (Canary Wireless) located at 14001 Newport Ave.

[REDACTED] told me Preciado was in the store for approximately 4 to 5 minutes before asking to see the Galaxy SII 4G. Arreaga told me he was nervous when Preciado entered the store because he recognized him as the same subject who stole a phone from the store before.

[REDACTED] said Preciado was dressed like a gangster and his demeanor was intimidating. [REDACTED] told me he has seen gangsters in the past and has heard about them on the news. He associates a gangster with baggy clothing, tattoos and a shaved head; all of which Preciado had. He told me gang members carry weapons under baggy clothing and he believed Preciado might have been carrying a gun. He told me he has seen multiple stories on the news of gang members using guns to commit crimes. He said Preciado "Stared him down" in order to intimidate him. He said Preciado was intimidating and demanding while he was in the store.

He told me Preciado asked to see the Galaxy SII 4G and asked to hold the box. [REDACTED] told him he could not hold the box and held onto the box while Preciado read the text. [REDACTED] told me he had a firm grip on the box with his right hand because he was afraid Preciado was going to try and take it.

[REDACTED] said Preciado grabbed the box from him with his right hand. He said the force that Preciado used to take the box ripped it from his hands and caused his body to be pulled forward. [REDACTED] told me he did not attempt to chase Preciado because he was fearful that he had a gun. He said Preciado reached into his waistband as he was leaving the store,

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acting as if he was reaching for a gun. [REDACTED] told me he did not want to chase after Preciado because, "It's not worth getting shot in the face over a phone". [REDACTED] told me that it would have been very easy for Preciado to conceal a ".380" under his baggy clothing.

I contacted [REDACTED] over the phone and spoke with her about the incident. [REDACTED] told me she works at a dental office located at [REDACTED]. She is friends with [REDACTED] and went over to the Canary Mobile store to talk with him. She said she was leaning against the front counter talking with [REDACTED] when she felt like someone was behind her. She turned around and observed Preciado who was standing inches away from her, invading her "personal space".

[REDACTED] described Preciado as being dressed like a gang member. I asked her what she meant by a gang member and she said he was wearing a very baggy white shirt, basketball style shorts, he had his socks pulled up and had a hat on his head. She could tell he had been involved in some sort of altercation previously because he had a red and swollen right eye. She said it looked as if a blood vessel had burst in his eye.

[REDACTED] said she has gang members in her family, has seen gang members on the news and knows what a gang member looks like when she sees one. She said she was immediately intimidated by Preciado because of his gang style and demeanor with [REDACTED]. She told me she associated gang members with weapons such as knives and guns and was not sure what Preciado was concealing under his baggy attire.

[REDACTED] said Preciado started talking to [REDACTED] about the iPhone and was upset when [REDACTED] told him they did not have any in stock. She said Preciado was talking in "gang slang words" such as "eh" and purposely using incorrect grammar. She said he asked to see a certain phone that was hanging on display. When [REDACTED] would not let him hold the box he

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became aggravated. [REDACTED] told me she was scared and backed up towards the front door. She said she stood in the northeast corner of the store and observed Preciado grab the phone away from [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] said Preciado did not run from the store with the phone. She told me he glared at [REDACTED] and said, "Now you can say I yanked it from you". She said Preciado did not run from the store, but walked in an intimidating manner towards the door. She said he glared at her as he approached the door and closer to where she was standing. She told me she felt like she was going to be shot and told her mother that evening how scared she was. She said there was no way she was going to run after Preciado because it was not worth dying for a phone. She said she tried to keep her eyes down at the ground because she was too scared to look at him in the face.

I spoke with [REDACTED] reference the video surveillance in the store. He told me there is no video surveillance of the incident that occurred in May (CR#13-2665) where Preciado stole a phone from the store. He said the video surveillance automatically deletes itself after a two week period. He handed me a memory drive that he said contained video footage in the store on 6/3/13.

I attempted to view the footage but was unsuccessful. The memory drive did not contain any video surveillance of the incident. I returned the memory drive and contacted [REDACTED] to request a new memory drive of DVD of the store surveillance footage.

I was able to view the video surveillance on [REDACTED] cellular phone using an iPhone application. The video collaborates what both witnesses told me about Preciado's demeanor, statements and actions. The audio is difficult to hear due to background noise.

Brief Summary of Incident (Attach additional pages if necessary)

After dispatch received a report of a robbery from the Boost Mobil store at the corner of Newport Ave and El Camino Real officers responded and began an area check for the suspect. The clerk described the suspect as a male Hispanic wearing a white T-shirt, black shorts and a black ball cap with short dark hair, a bruised right eye and a tattoo on his right forearm. As Officer Newton was conducting an area check he observed a male Hispanic matching the suspect's description running across Walnut Ave eastbound to southbound Newport Ave. When Officer Newton attempted to stop the suspect, later identified as PRECIADO, Preciado became verbally combative by yelling profanities and questioning the stop. Due to the fact Preciado was standing on the other side of a set of bushes, Officer Newton could not see Preciado's hands so Officer Newton ordered Preciado to walk around the bushes and to sit down and Preciado reluctantly complied. As Preciado was sitting on the ground facing Officer Newton, he began to move around and at one point began to place his hands into his pockets despite Officer Newton's commands not to do so. Fearing Preciado may have a weapon, Officer Newton grabbed Preciado's left arm and attempted to place Preciado's hand behind his back. Preciado respond by jerking his arm away from Officer Newton and attempted to stand up. Officer Newton then placed the weight of his body onto Preciado in order to keep him down until responding officers arrived. As Preciado continued to struggle to stand-up Officer Newton punched Preciado three times to the right side of Preciado's head in an attempt to gain his compliance. This had no affect and Preciado

continued to struggle. Officer Newton then punched Preciado an additional three more times in the head at which point Officer Thronton arrived and assisted with successfully handcuffing Preciado.

When I arrived approximately one minute later, I observed Preciado's right eye was swollen and there was blood coming from an existing wound with sutures to the right side of Preciado's eyebrow. I asked Preciado what had happened and he told me he was stopped for no reason and that after Officer Newton told him to stop, Officer Newton walked up to him and punched him in the face for no reason. Preciado was later transported to Santa Ana Western Medical center for further treatment. While Preciado was at the hospital he spoke with Detective Sandoval and told him he had received the cut to the right side of his eye and a black eye from an earlier fight he had with an unknown subject.

It was determined during Preciado's medical treatment that the orbit bone around his right eye was fractured and he would require additional medical treatment. However, due to the fact Preciado was reported to have an existing injury to his right eye prior to his contact with Officer Newton, I was not able to determine whether his injury was the result of his confrontation with Officer Newton.
