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SYNOPSIS

Suspect stopped for reckless driving and physically resists police officers when contacted. Upon arrest, he was found to have possession of two illegal knives and assaulted three officers. Suspect later booked at OCJ.

NARRATIVE

On 07-06-2015 Officer Stroud and I were working a uniform patrol assignment, driving a marked Tustin Police patrol vehicle. We were at TPD writing reports in the assigned report writing area. We heard over the radio Sergeant Arzate stop a vehicle and advised the "driver was unresponsive". We heard Sergeant Arzate request an additional unite Code 3 (flashing red and blue lights with audible sirens). Officer Girgenti responded Code 3 and arrived on scene.

Upon Officer Girgenti's arrival, he advised over the radio and requested two additional units to respond Code 3. Due to the fact we were in the station and the furthest away from the initial stop, we responded code 1. Prior to our arrival, the following officers had already arrived on scene:

- Officer Muro
- Officer Ryan
- Officer Crouch
- Officer Fitzpatrick
- Sergeant Cartwright
- K-9 Officer Barazza
- Sergeant Arzate
- Officer Girgenti
- Officer Kirwan

When we arrived, the officers on scene had already begun initiating a high risk traffic stop and were attempting to get the driver of the vehicle to walk back to our vehicles. Refer to Sergeant Arzate and Sergeant Cartwright's supplemental reports for further details.

I observed the suspect walking backwards but when he was ordered to go down onto his knees for officer safety, the suspect was not compliant.

While walking up to the stop, officers requested an arrest team (Officers assigned to handcuff suspect) be assigned. Officer Stroud and I verbally advised we would be the arrest team. Once subject had walked 10-15 feet in front of a marked unit, Officer Stroud and I proceeded forward to

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the subject after an officer asked where the arrest team was. Refer to Officer Stroud's supplemental report for details of the arrest.

Later when reviewing Officer Girgenti's MAVS video, I observed I was struck on the left side of my face by the suspect's right open hand while we were attempting to place handcuffs on Edmonds. Initially, I did not feel the strike due to the commotion and adrenaline. During the incident on the ground, I noticed Edmonds hands were tucked inside near his armpits and appeared to be reaching for something inside his jacket. Verbal warnings were given by Officers Stroud and Girgenti to "stop resisting" but Edmonds did not comply.

Refer to Officer Stroud and Officer Girgenti's supplemental reports for further details on their force necessary to place Edmonds in handcuffs. Edmonds was rolled to his side in an attempt to assist him in standing up. As Edmonds was escorted behind our marked vehicles, I noticed a large fixed kitchen knife in a plastic cover on the ground approximately 2-3 feet from where Edmonds was on the ground. After Edmonds was escorted behind our marked vehicles, I conducted a search incident to Edmonds' arrest. I located a large fixed kitchen steak knife (approximately 10 inches) inside his inner left jacket pocket in addition to other miscellaneous items. See attached paperwork for further details.

Right after placing Edmonds in the car, Officer Stroud asked if he needed any medical attention. Edmonds said "Take me to the Marine base in San Diego, Camp Pendleton". Edmonds was later transported to TPD to complete booking paperwork.

Officers Barazza and Kirwan conducted a vehicle search and uncovered one additional knife inside the vehicle. Refer to Officer Barazza's supplemental report for further detail.

While on scene, CHP Officer Patrick Cardoza advised me the following: Charles Edmonds was involved in a hit and run traffic collision near Valley View and the southbound 5 freeway. Edmonds continued to drive on the 5 freeway and exited off Red Hill Ave, which was where Sergeant Arzate first observed him. Refer to Officer Cardoza's report (#201501453).

It should be noted that CHP handled the towing of Edmonds' vehicle.

Back at TPD sally port, Edmonds refused to speak to us and refused to answer any medical questions as well. We were able to identify Edmonds with the Pennsylvania Identification cards that were with his property. When we attempted to transfer Edmonds to the TPD interview room, he was physically resisting and was not cooperating. When Officer Stroud grabbed Edmonds, he made his

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body limp, making it difficult for us to move him. Edmonds was placed in a restraint chair. See Sergeant Arzate's supplemental report for further information.

I read Edmonds his Miranda rights directly from my department issued Miranda Card. Edmonds refused to respond to each admonishment.

During this time, Edmonds complained about wrist and rib pains and requested that he wanted to go to a hospital. Refer to Officer Stroud's supplemental report for further detail. Paramedics responded and transported Edmonds to Western Medical in Santa Ana. Refer to Sergeant Arzate and Officer Crouch's supplemental reports for further details.

Due to the incident while on the ground, Officers Stroud and Girgenti suffered visible lacerations on both knees. Refer to Officers Stroud and Girgenti's supplemental report for further details regarding their injuries. I did not observe or feel any pain or bruising on my left side of my face from Edmonds strike. I took photos of the injuries and later downloaded them to the TPD computer database. See the attached photos for further detail.

The two knives found on Edmonds were later booked into TPD property as evidence. See the attached TPD property sheet for further details.

After being medically cleared, Edmonds was booked into the Orange County Jail by Officer Nikolic. Initially Edmonds refused to submit a DNA sample. It should be noted that Officer Nikolic obtained a consensual DNA sample at OCJ.

I request this report be forwarded to the Orange County District Attorney's Office for review. I request the following charge be filed against Charles Edmonds:

- PC 69 (3 Victims) – Resisting an Officer
- PC 241 (c) – Assault against Peace Officer (Zhao)
- PC 243 (b) – Battery against Peace Officer (Zhao)
- PC 243 (c)(2)- Battery against a Peace Officer with Injury (Girgenti)
- PC 243 (c)(2)- Battery against a Peace Officer with Injury (Stroud)
- PC 148 (a)(1) – Resisting /Obstructing Peace Officer
- PC 21310 – Carrying Dirk/Dagger concealed upon person

**Narrative:**

On 7-06-15 at approximately 0051 hours I was on patrol in marked TPD patrol unit with Officer Zhao. We were both wearing our TPD issued patrol uniforms. We responded to a high risk car stop on San Juan east of Redhill Avenue. Refer to Officer Zhao's original report for details.

Officer Zhao and I had the arrest responsibilities at the scene while the other officers watched the vehicle in fear of additional subjects that may still be inside and refusing to come out. Sgt. Arzate was giving verbal commands to the suspect (Charles Darnell Edmonds) to walk backwards from the vehicle to our marked units in order for officers to handcuff him.

Once Edmonds was approximately ten feet in front of one of the marked units, officers began giving Edmonds verbal commands to get down on his knees which he was not complying with. Officers began verbally asking where the arrest team was due to the fact Edmonds was not only refusing to kneel down, but continually reaching toward his front waistband and chest area.

When officers asked where the arrest team was, I began walking forward and past the other officers to where Edmonds was standing in order to place him in handcuffs. I attempted to grab the upper portion of his collar, and push forward his left knee in an attempt to have him kneel down to the ground to place him in handcuffs.

As soon as I touched his collar and knee, Edmonds immediately turned around to face me and used his left hand to grab my firearm (on the right side of my hip). While struggling with Edmonds, a kitchen style knife fell to the ground from somewhere in his lower abdomen area.

I was unable to draw my firearm in response to the knife to defend myself from Edmonds because he was still physically holding on to me and may have been able to grab the gun from me. While attempting to take Edmonds to the ground away from the knife and place him in handcuffs, he used his open palmed right hand to hit Officer Zhao in the face.

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I then physically escorted Edmonds to the ground and attempted to turn him onto his stomach to again attempt to place him in handcuffs. While Edmonds was on the ground, he physically resisted turning onto his back and was continually attempting to reach for something inside his jacket in the upper pectoral region.

Due to the fact Edmonds had already grabbed my firearm, struck Officer Zhao in the face, dropped a fixed blade knife which had been concealed, and was not reaching for another concealed portion of his person, I felt an immediate threat toward my life and Officer Zhao's.

Due to the fact I was still not in a safe position to draw my firearm or any less lethal weapon as Edmonds was close enough to grab them from me, I began using my fist to strike him to prevent him from grabbing a concealed weapon from his person and to gain compliance to place him in handcuffs. I punched him three times as he was attempting to reach inside his jacket.

After multiple verbal commands from myself, Officer Zhao, and Officer Girgenti, to place his hands behind his back and stop resisting us, Edmonds still continued to physically fight and push us away. He then rolled over to his stomach concealing his hands from our view in his pectoral region.

After approximately another five strikes to his lower body region with my right fist, he continued reaching in concealed areas and physically refusing to put his hands behind his back which prevented us from handcuffing him. The strikes I was deploying seemed to not affect him and he was continuing to reach toward the concealed interior pockets of his jacket.

Due to the fact he was continuing to reach in the concealed pockets, I physically used an additional six strikes, and he finally stopped reaching in concealed areas of his jacket and finally put his hands behind his back allowing Officer Zhao to place him in handcuffs. It should be noted the area he was reaching for was where a fixed blade kitchen knife was later located.

After he was handcuffed, no additional strikes or physical force from any officer was applied.

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After he was placed in handcuffs, Officer Zhao and I walked him back behind the marked units and conducted a search of his person. Refer to Officer Zhao's original report reference the additional knife she recovered from his person during this search.

After removing the property from his person, Edmonds was placed in the back seat of our marked TPD unit. I did not see any visible injuries to Edmonds at this time. I asked Edmonds if he was injured or wanted medical attention, and he would answer with only a request to take him to a military base. He was then transported back to TPD for processing.

It should be noted during the altercation with Edmonds, I received multiple lacerations and bruises to my knees and also holes to both legs of my department issued pants. See attached photographs for details.

At TPD, Edmonds continued to be physically resistant resulting in him being placed in the TPD restraint chair. Refer to Officer Zhao and Sgt. Arzate's report for details.

After being in the chair for approximately 30-45 minutes, Edmonds complained his wrists were hurting him. I immediately removed the chest restraints from the chair on Edmonds and loosened both of his handcuffs. Edmonds still complained his wrists were hurting to I used a second pair of handcuffs on him in an attempt to relieve his pain.

Edmonds then stated his wrists felt better but his side was hurting. I then removed Edmonds from the restraint chair completely and placed him on a regular chair where he positioned himself so he was no longer in pain. Due to the fact Edmonds stated his side was hurting but I could not see any visible injuries there, I requested medics respond to TPD in case Edmonds had suffered an internal injury that was not visible.

Medics arrived and transported Edmonds to the hospital. Refer to Sgt. Arzate and Officer Crouch's supplemental report for further details.

**Narrative:**

On 07-06-15 at approximately 0051 hours, I parked in the parking lot of the "Big Lots" located at 13852 Red Hill Ave. when I heard what appeared to be metal grinding against the pavement. I heard an unknown person shout "Holly shit!," at which time I saw a dark colored van (Pennsylvania License Plate [REDACTED] driving north bound on Red Hill Ave. from El Camino Real with sparks flying approximately 3' to 5' from the rear of the vehicle.

I entered onto Red Hill Ave. and positioned my patrol car behind the vehicle to initiate a traffic stop. I noticed the sparks were coming from the rear driver's side wheel well, which had no tire, and the sparks were being generated from the rotor/rim spinning on the asphalt. The van was driving approximately 30 mph on Red Hill Ave. then turned E/B on San Juan. I initiated my overhead lights and siren and the vehicle yielded on San Juan E/O Red Hill Ave.

I ordered the driver later identified as, Charles Edmonds, to roll his window down and place his hands outside of the window three times and he did not comply. The windows of Edmonds' vehicle were dark colored and covered in dust and debris. I could see Edmonds making furtive movements inside his vehicle rather than placing his hands outside as instructed. Due to the uncertain circumstances involving the damage to Edmonds' vehicle, lack of compliance to my commands and furtive movements, I requested additional unit respond Code-3 (lights and siren) to assist me.

Officer Girgenti was the first officer to arrive to the scene. While waiting for additional officers to arrive to conduct a high risk traffic stop, Edmonds exited the passenger's side door without being instructed. Edmonds was out of my view and I was concerned for my safety, so I ordered him back inside the vehicle until additional patrol units arrived to assist.

Sgt. Cartwright was the second officer to arrive at the scene and he positioned himself in an area where he was able to view Edmonds' furtive movements more closely. While inside the vehicle Edmonds continued to make furtive movements and Sgt. Cartwright was verbally advising me of Edmonds' actions. (See Sgt. Cartwright's supplemental report for additional details.)

When sufficient units arrived to the scene, I ordered Edmonds out of the vehicle.

I had Edmonds walk back toward my vehicle and he displayed slow lethargic movements, an unsteady gait and he had difficulty following directions. I ultimately ordered Edmonds to kneel down on his knees. Edmonds did not comply with six requests to kneel down on his knees.

Edmonds said he had "bad knees" and he had to use the restroom. Based on the fact Edmonds would not comply with directions, an arrest team consisting of Officer Stroud, Officer Zhao and Officer Girgenti approached where he was standing. Officer Stroud placed his hands on Edmonds' shoulders and applied pressure to the rear of Edmonds' left leg. Edmonds then quickly spun towards Officer Stroud while placing his hand near Officer Stroud's duty firearm. Edmonds resisted arrest and was ultimately taken into custody where he was found to be in possession of two fixed blade knives which were concealed on his person. (See Officer Stroud's, Officer Girgenti's and Officer Zhao's arrest/supplemental reports for details of the arrest.)

Edmonds was transported to TPD, where he refused to answer any medical questions. I asked Officer Stroud to bring Edmonds into the TPD interview room to conduct a drug/alcohol influence examination. When Officer Stroud had Edmonds stand up he immediately allowed his body to go completely limp. Officer Stroud had to hold Edmonds' up to prevent him from falling on the concrete floor and injuring himself. Officer Stroud walked Edmonds to the TPD restraint chair where he could be secured to prevent injury to himself or TPD personnel. Officer Stroud, Officer Zhao and I attempted to place Edmonds in the restraint chair and he bowed his back to prevent us from placing him in a seated position. Edmonds remained extremely rigid to prevent being properly secured in the restraint chair. Edmonds was under constant observation while inside the restraint chair for an approximately 30-45 minutes. While Edmonds was secured in the restraint chair, I attempted to conduct an eye examination but he refused to open his eyes.

I left the sally port when Edmonds was secured in the restraint chair.

Based on Edmonds erratic driving (30 mph with no tire), failure to follow instructions, unsteady gait, slurred speech, fumbling of unknown objects, I formed the opinion he was under the influence of a CNS Depressant/Narcotic Analgesic. Edmonds complained of pain to his back/rib area and was transported to Western Medical Center, Santa Ana for further evaluation.

Edmonds refused to provide a blood sample; therefore, I authored a search warrant to obtain a sample of his blood. The search warrant was approved by DDA Andrew Katz and signed by the Honorable Judge Goethals. CPT Blood Technician Caesar Vasquez drew a sample of Edmonds blood. (See Officer Crouch's supplemental report for details regarding the blood draw.)

I later responded to the hospital and took photos of Edmonds with Officer Crouch's camera. Edmonds complained of pain to his lower right rib area and had no visible injuries on his person. The photos were later uploaded into the TPD photo database. Edmonds initial prognosis was a fracture to rib and spine area. Edmonds was medically cleared from Western Medical Center shortly thereafter and booked into OCJ.

**NARRATIVE:**

On 07-05-15 at approximately 0051 hours, I was working uniformed patrol in a marked police vehicle. I responded Code 3 (Lights and sirens) to the area of San Juan east of Red Hill Av to assist Sergeant Arzate with a high risk traffic stop of a Dodge van (Penn Lic [REDACTED]). Refer to Officer Zhao and Stroud's narrative for further details.

When I arrived at the location, I observed the vehicle's left rear tire was missing and there was movement inside the vehicle, causing it to sway back and forth. A male subject, later identified as Charles Edmonds ([REDACTED]), exited the vehicle from the passenger side then was ordered back into the vehicle by Sergeant Arzate for officer safety reasons. Refer to Sergeant Arzate's supplemental narrative for further details.

Edmonds later exited the vehicle and was given directions to walk back toward the marked police units. Once Edmonds got to within approximately 8 feet from the marked police vehicles, Arzate gave Edmonds a verbal command to go to a kneeling position for officer safety reasons.

Edmond's refused to go into the kneeling position as ordered. Officers Stroud and Zhao approached Edmonds to go handcuff him. I observed Edmonds strike Officer Stroud with a closed right hand. After watching the MAVS video, I observed Officer Zhao was struck by Edmond's open right hand on the left side of her face. Refer to Officer Zhao and Stroud's narrative for further details.

Officer Stroud and Edmond's momentum took them both to the ground where Edmond's continued to fight. I ran over to assist Officers Zhao and Stroud take Edmonds into custody without further incident.

When I arrived, Edmonds was resisting Officers Zhao and Stroud. I verbally commanded Edmonds to "Stop Resisting" several times but he did not comply with my hands. I attempted to gain control of Edmonds hands but I was unable to because he became rigid and resisted.

I struck Edmonds approximately three times in his left front torso area. I commanded Edmonds to roll over to his stomach but he did not comply and moved his hands closer to his chest area. I could feel Edmonds muscles tensing as he continued to resist.

I then struck Edmonds approximately two times with my right knee in his left rib cage area. The second time I struck Edmonds, he complied with commands, placed his hands behind his back and was placed into handcuffs. Refer to Officers Zhao and Stroud's narrative for further details.

As I arrived on scene I saw the driver, who was later identified as Edmonds, exiting the front passenger door. I heard Sgt. Arzate give Edmonds commands to get back into the van and he complied.

The rear window of the van was dark and I could not see inside. I moved to a private driveway southwest of the van and could see inside through the right side windows. I saw Edmonds on his knees facing backwards on the front passenger seat. It appeared Edmonds was digging into his front right waistband area with his right hand. I saw his slow and deliberate movements continue up and down towards his waistband area three or four times.

Edmonds leaned further between the front two captain's seats of the vehicle and reached down towards the rear passenger compartment, behind the front right seat. Edmonds appeared to be rummaging through the van's contents, but I could not see what he was reaching for. Edmonds leaned further between the two front seats and reached to the right rear floorboard area. It appeared Edmonds was looking for something inside of the van. Edmonds raised back up while still kneeling backwards in the seat and I could no longer see where his hands were.

Several other officers arrived and Edmonds was given commands to exit the vehicle. Edmonds was eventually taken into custody.

Edmonds was later cleared by the hospital for jail booking. Officer Nikolic responded to the hospital and transported Edmonds to the Orange County Jail.

1 **FACTS:**

3 **NOTIFICATION:**

5 On Monday, July 06, 2015, at approximately 0100 hours, I monitored a broadcast by Orange County  
6 Communication Center of a two vehicle collision with unknown details. Orange County Communication

**NARRATIVE:**

On 07-06-15 I was working uniformed patrol. I was maintaining custody of a suspect while he was receiving medical treatment at Western Medical Center.

The suspect, Charles Edmonds underwent CT scans, X-rays, and other examinations. The attending doctor at the hospital informed Edmonds that he had a fractured right rib and a fracture in the lumbar area of his spine.

Officer Nikolic assumed custody of Edmonds in order to transport him to the hospital. I gave Officer Nikolic Edmond's property, his jail booking paperwork, and the receipt for the blood draw.

Following the conclusion of my shift, I was informed by Sergeant Arzate that the blood draw receipt was unaccounted for within the report. I confirmed I did not still have the receipt.

Sergeant Arzate later contacted California Forensic Phlebotomy, Inc. He obtained a photograph of the blood draw receipt, which I had signed at the hospital. The vial number in which Edmonds' blood was stored in was "639192."

I printed out the photograph of the blood draw receipt and have included it in this supplemental report.

A suspicious vehicle was observed driving N/B on Red Hill Ave. on the rim/rotor resulting in a trail of 3' to 5' of sparks. TPD Officers later learned the vehicle was involved in a hit and run traffic collision near the 5 Freeway and Valley View. A high risk traffic stop was conducted and the driver would not comply with verbal commands and made several furtive movements. As the suspect was being taken into custody, he swung his arm towards an officer's firearm (Stroud) and struck another officer (Zhao) in the head/neck area. While the suspect was being taken into custody a fixed blade knife fell from his person. The suspect refused to produce his hands and attempted to reach into his clothing where a second fixed blade knife was discovered.

The suspect was struck by TPD officers several times with fists/knees in the upper torso and was transported to Western Medical Center, Santa Ana. The suspect was treated briefly at the hospital for a fractured right rib and fractured lumbar area of his spine. The suspect was booked into the Orange County Jail.

The suspect was interviewed at the hospital and denied striking TPD Officers and resisting/delaying arrest. The suspect said he possessed the knives for protection. The suspect was unsure if he sustained the injuries during the traffic collision or while being taken into custody. The suspect appeared to be under the influence and suffering from an unknown mental illness.

Reviewer comment:

After reviewing the attachments and MAVS videos, this UOF could have been prevented or minimized by the use of department trained control techniques and tactics. Tactically, officers could have waited longer and engaged the suspect, providing other options to place him in position of disadvantage. Engaging the suspect quickly in a hand to hand encounter, believing he was armed, placed the officers in the position of disadvantage.

Secondly, Officer Stroud used a take down technique which has not been taught during arrest and control training. Grabbing a suspect by the shoulders provides no control over the suspect and allows him to easily avoid being restrained. By using this technique, Officer Stroud placed himself and other officers into a position where the suspect was face up, on his back, where officers were now forced to use strikes in order to gain control over the suspect.

The arrest and control staff does train officers in the use of strikes and kicks to use in self defense which would be applicable in this situation based on the officers fear for their safety because of the suspects actions during the encounter.

Reviewer comment:

I have reviewed this Use of Force incident including all associated police reports, MAVS videos and recorded suspect interview. I have also reviewed the attached Use of Force critique submitted by Sgt. Quinn. Although some arrest and control techniques could have been performed in a different manner during the incident, I think the force used was reasonable and within policy.

This incident began when Sgt. Arzate saw Edmonds driving N/B Red Hill from the I-5 Freeway at about 0100 hours. There was obvious damage to the rear driver's side of the vehicle and as the vehicle traveled N/B Red Hill, there was a large plume of sparks emitting from the driver's side rear axle/hub area. Arzate had reasonable suspicion to stop the vehicle and did so in the area of San Juan E/O Red Hill. The driver of the vehicle

was later identified as Charles Edmonds.

Arzate suspected Edmonds had been involved in some type of vehicle collision, likely a hit and run, so he called for additional officers to respond. Arzate waited in a position of cover behind his patrol vehicle and ordered Edmonds to place his hands out of the driver's side window. Edmonds did not comply and within a short time, exited the passenger side of the vehicle. Edmonds then re-entered the vehicle until additional officers arrived. Once officers established a modified felony car stop, they ordered Edmonds out of the car.

As Arzate directed Edmonds to walk backwards towards the police vehicles, he stumbled as if under the influence. Edmonds refused to keep his hands extended over his head and he can be seen in the MAVS video holding a large set of keys. After a few minutes and numerous orders, Edmonds eventually reached the location the officers determined was the best to physically detain him. This was just in front of Arzate and Girgenti's police vehicles.

While standing in this location, Edmonds was ordered multiple times to keep his hands above his head. Edmonds did not comply with these commands; dropping his hands in front of his torso and turning to look at the officers behind him. When Edmonds dropped his hands, he brought them towards his chest where they could not be seen. As the incident continued, Edmonds was given a total of six commands to drop to his knees. Edmonds did not comply with any of these commands and eventually turned towards the officers to say he had bad knees.

When Edmonds refused the commands to drop to his knees, Stroud and Zhao approached from behind to take Edmonds into custody. Stroud placed his hands on Edmonds' shoulders while simultaneously placing his right knee in the bend of Edmonds' leg in an attempt to force Edmonds to the ground. Edmonds immediately pulled from Stroud and turned to his right. With his left hand, Edmonds reached around and grabbed Stroud's torso just above his service weapon on the right side of his holster. Stroud's police report indicates Edmonds tried to grab his (Stroud's) pistol, but this is difficult to determine from the video. It is clear Edmonds' left hand was in the immediate area of Stroud's weapon, but it does not appear he actually grabbed ahold of it. Because this movement occurred so quickly, it appears reasonable Stroud would think Edmonds was attempting to grab ahold of his firearm.

After Edmonds spun away from the officers, he took a few steps backwards then fell to the ground on his back. Stroud and Zhao bent down to control Edmonds and Edmonds immediately swung and struck Zhao in the face with his left hand. It was only after Edmonds struck Zhao that Stroud began striking Edmonds. It appears from the MAVS video, Stroud struck Edmonds in the face once and the remainder of the strikes were to the torso.

After the initial few strikes, Edmonds rolled to his stomach and would not remove his hands from under his upper torso. Stroud struck Edmonds six more times in the upper torso before Edmonds moved his hands to his back and was eventually handcuffed. Edmonds had a fixed blade knife concealed in his inside jacket pocket which is where he was reaching when Stroud, Zhao and Girgenti were attempting to take him into custody. Edmonds was in possession of a second fixed blade knife that fell to the ground during the initial struggle with the officers.

Although Sgt. Quinn indicated this use of force could have been prevented or minimized with the use of different control techniques or tactics, I don't think given these specific circumstances that the officers acted unreasonably. From the initial stages of this incident Edmonds

continued to defy officer commands. He would not keep his hands where officers could see them and would not get on the ground as ordered. At this point in the incident, I don't think the officers had any other option than to approach Edmonds in an attempt to take him into custody. The use of a Taser, impact munitions or police K-9 would not have been reasonable just because Edmonds refused to get on the ground. The minimal force Stroud used in an attempt to force Edmonds to the ground caused Edmonds to respond with violence and I do not think placing control holds at that point of the contact would have had any different effect.

Once forced to the ground, Edmonds immediately struggled with officers and struck Zhao in the face. According to Stroud, a knife had already fallen from Edmonds' person at this point in the incident, so the threat level had increased. After Edmonds rolled to his stomach area, the officers were unable to see or control his hands which increased the level of concern even more. According to Sgt. Quinn, strikes and kicks are taught to officers during arrest and control training and in my opinion were reasonable and within policy during this incident.
