

City of Tustin Parks and Recreation Scholarship Program FAQ

How can I apply for a scholarship?

2. Print out the application and mail to:

3. Come in person to the Parks and Recreation office.

All applications and scholarship enrollments are processed at the Parks and Recreation office ONLY!

What do I need to provide?

1. Scholarship application (all applications must be filled out completely or it will be returned to the applicant)
2. Letter explaining current need and why your child should be considered for a scholarship

Can I receive a 100% scholarship?

A family will be responsible for paying at least 50% of each program a child enrolls in.

How much assistance can I receive?

A qualifying family receive only one class per calendar year. Scholarships are for individual classes and the class number requested must be indicated on the form. Scholarships are considered on a case by case basis.

When are applications accepted?

Applications are accepted year-round or until funds run out, whichever occurs first.

What is not included in the scholarship?

The scholarship program does not include additional program fees such as costumes, material fees, insurance, etc.

When should applications be submitted?

All applications must be submitted two (2) weeks prior to the start of the program. Applicants will be notified within one (1) week of application submittal.

Is assistance for youth and adults?

Scholarships are for youth age 17 and under.

Please note, all decisions regarding assistance are final.
